

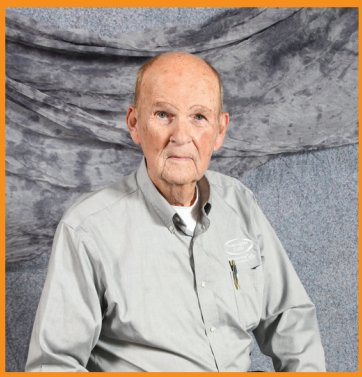
TRUSTEE NOMINATIONS
