Scholarship Details

PURPOSE:

In order to carry on an educational and training program that encourages Ohio's rural youth to further their education and gives them an opportunity to become more aware of careers in the rural electric program, the PowerUP Technical scholarship award program is offered by North Western Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NWEC) and Ohio's Electric Cooperatives, Inc. (OEC).

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

One winner will receive a \$1,000 cash award each year. The award is non-renewable. The local winner will advance to the statewide level where they will compete for additional cash.

INTERVIEWS

In-person interviews will be held and all eligible applicants are required to participate in order to be considered for the scholarship award. Additional information regarding the date, location and specific interview times will be mailed to the applicants.

	Application form (two pages) - Information must be confined to the official form. Applications must be submitted by 4 p.m. on Friday, February 14, 2025.					
	An official, signed grade transcript Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.					
	One essay - typed, <u>250 word</u> maximum Essay must detail your educational and career goals. Describe the reasons why you chose that path.					
	One letter of recommendation The letter may be typed or handwritten and must be no longer than <u>500 words</u> .					
	A recent photo of the applicant - A photocopy of a photo is acceptable.

Scholarship Rules

The following provisions will govern the acceptance of applicants for the PowerUP Technical Scholarship:

- Applicants must be the son, daughter, or <u>legal</u> ward of a permanent <u>residential</u> NWEC member receiving service for the duration of the 2024-2025 academic year (August 2024 - June 2025). Children/wards of NWEC <u>commercial</u> members are not eligible unless one of their parents/legal guardians is also a permanent <u>residential</u> NWEC member.
- 2. Applicants may be high school graduates enrolling in a technical program; current technical school enrollees or those enrolling in a post-undergraduate technical program. Applicants must plan to attend or currently attend an accredited technical school program.
- 3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of <u>**2.5 or above</u>** on a 4.0 scale or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.</u>
- 4. Winners must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited vocational/technical school to claim their scholarship. Winners who are accepted and then enrolled in an accredited school of nursing, working toward a degree, are also eligible.
- 5. Scholarships must be claimed within six months of the date on the winner's notification letter. Extensions may be granted for just cause if requested in writing before July 1, 2025.
- 6. Students may not be immediate family members of, or reside with, people who are employed by any electric cooperative in Ohio (employees, trustees, managers, OEC, **or** affiliated organizations such as Buckeye Power, Inc., RESCO, etc.).
- 7. Applicants who receive "full-ride" scholarships (i.e., scholarships that cover the cost of tuition, room, board *and* books) to the schools of their choice are **not eligible** for scholarships from NWEC or OEC.
- 8. When selecting the annual winner, preference will be given to applicants who will be, or are currently, pursuing a career in an electrical related field of study.
- 9. These rules supersede all previous rules for this scholarship.
